



Summer 2020 Covid-19 Response Guidelines

We are committed to the safety and well-being of all our campers and staff this summer. We will operate within the guidelines established by the CDC, American Camp Association, YUSA, and state and local health departments. The changes below reflect these guidelines and have the best interest of every camper at heart.

Check-in:

- Your arrival time to camp will be pre-assigned to limit the number of individuals on property at any given time
- We ask that only 1 caregiver per household / vehicle escort their camper/s to check-in
- Each camper must have a signed Covid-19 waiver and health acknowledgement
- Each camper must pass a temperature screening upon entry
- Parents will not have the ability to tour camp, access to the camp property will be limited
- Staff assisting with luggage will be in PPE
- Staff administering check-in will be in proper PPE to help you with your luggage and the check-in process

Housing:

- Up to 10 campers and 2 counselors will be assigned to a sleeping cabin for the entire week
- Cabin access will be limited to the individuals assigned, unless there is an emergency that requires additional staff
- Sleeping arrangement:
 - Bunks will be separated by six-feet when possible
 - Bunks will be set up in "head-to-toe" fashion to maximize distance between head/face
- Campers are asked to bring essential-items only to camp and to keep all of their belongings in their assigned cubbies

Food Service:

- All staff preparing meals and serving meals follow strict hand washing protocol and wear proper PPE
- To increase ventilation, windows in dining areas will be open as much as possible. Outdoor eating will be encouraged.
- Meals will be served either "grab and go" or family-style. Meals served family-style will be handled at the dining table and served by staff wearing proper PPE.
- Sanitation of all dining areas will occur before and immediately after each meal

Transportation:

- Charter bus transportation, provided by Jet Limousine, is still provided to and from camp. Increased cleaning and sanitizing protocol is being followed by Jet Limousine.
- Health screenings for each camper are required before they are permitted onto the bus (see "Check-In" section for more details)
- The bus capacity is limited to 26 campers to account for social distancing.



Sanitation:

- Sky-Y has created a daily sanitation team that is dedicated to cleaning
- Program area equipment will be sanitized between each group's use
- All campers will wash their hands between each activity, approximately every 30 minutes
- Shower facilities are sanitized between each group's use
- Bathroom cleaning and sanitizing occurs across the entire property multiple times a day
